SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing an agreement between the County of Westchester and Community Capital New York, Inc., to provide funding to carry out fair and affordable housing and small business activities

The attached resolution authorizes the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with Community Capital New York, Inc. (CCNY). CCNY will carry out unique fair and affordable housing activities and small business support activities for an amount not to exceed \$106,090.00, to be paid pursuant to an approved budget. The term of the agreement is January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016.

CCNY will provide services which will include, but not be limited to: provide catalytic “gap” financing to no fewer than three Fair and Affordable housing developments in Westchester, with priority given to those developments that meet the requirements of the Westchester County Housing Settlement; guidance on access to capital for the owners of 150 start up and emerging small businesses in Westchester County; promotion of the availability of affordable homes to those who have signed on to the CCNY website; 300 hours of technical assistance to small businesses through workshops, one-on-one support, accounting training, coaching and networking activities. CCNY was not able to meet one of their goals for the 2015 contract period. Staff turnover prevented CCNY from reaching their goal of providing access to capital for 150 small business owners; they were able to provide guidance to 148 small business owners. We anticipate CCNY will meet or exceed all of their goals in 2016.

This agreement will provide housing activities that: ensure adequate access to capital by negotiating necessary lines of credit and program related investments and securing grant funds sufficient to meet the borrowing needs of fair and affordable housing developers; working with prospective borrowers to understand the financing gap their project is facing and what portion of it CCNY may be able to fill and what other resources may be available; preparing and filing all loan closing documents; management of projects that fail to move forward and need loan workouts and/or forgiveness.

The goal and objective of this agreement is to promote the provision of fair and affordable housing and to support the owners of small businesses. The service provided by CCNY is essential to the provision of affordable housing in Westchester County; the Department of Planning does not have the staff necessary to provide these valuable services. The program will be monitored by Department of Planning staff, who will review all payment requests to make sure all contractual requirements are met.

Authority to exempt this agreement from the requirements of the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures pursuant to Section 3(a) xxi thereof has been requested from your Honorable Board in accordance with a separate resolution of even date herewith.

Accordingly, a resolution to authorize an agreement with Community Capital New York, Inc. is hereby submitted for your consideration.

I recommend approval of this agreement.

**RESOLUTION**

UPON A COMMUNICATION FROM THE COMMISSIONER OF PLANNING, BE IT HEREBY
