Amount: \$252,600.00

On June 3, 2015, one (1) bid was received and opened for Contract No. 15-215 for Service Contract for Auto-Body Repair Work, Medium and Heavy Trucks, Department of Public Works and Transportation, Westchester County, New York.

One (1) contractor submitted a bid for this project. The project was advertised on the Empire State Purchasing Group website, in addition to the Journal News (Westchester-Putnam Edition), and was viewed by twelve (12) entities on the Empire State Purchasing Group website. In addition, e-mails were sent to those twelve (12) entities and to an additional thirty two (32) suppliers and contractors.

The original amount of Stiloski's Automotive Corp.'s bid was \$381,000.00 which was subsequently renegotiated down to \$252,600.00 in order to fall within the County's budgeted amount for this project. In accordance with the law, the renegotiated amount does not decrease in any way the scope of work set forth in the bid specification.

The bid was reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Stiloski's Automotive Corp. submitted the sole bid in the amount of \$252,600.00.

The sole bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Stiloski's Automotive Corp.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

Funds for this project are available in the:

- Capital Budget
 Non-Recurring Budget
 Operating Budget

The objective of this contract is to repair damaged Department of Public Works and Transportation fleet vehicles.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that damaged County fleet vehicles are repaired to meet all safety standards, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

This contract is for a term of three (3) years with one two (2) year renewal at the discretion of the County.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 15-215 be awarded to Stiloski's Automotive Corp. in the amount of \$252,600.00, subject to appropriations.

RESOLUTION

CONTRACT NO. 15-215

Upon communication from the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation, be it

RESOLVED, that Contract No. 15-215 for Service Contract for Auto-Body Repair Work, Medium and Heavy Trucks, Department of Public Works and Transportation, Westchester County, New York be and is hereby awarded to the sole bidder, Stiloski's Automotive Corp., 155 Wildey Street, Tarrytown, New York 10591, in the amount of \$252,600.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, that as set forth in the Contract No. 15-215 bid specifications this contract is for a term of three (3) years with one two (2) year renewal at the discretion of the County; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this contract is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
