The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that CTE Incorporated:

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by maintaining clean and sanitary conditions within County facilities.

RESOLVED, that Contract No. 15-222 for Janitorial Services at District Office, 100 East First Street, Mount Vernon, New York be and is hereby awarded to the low bidder, CTE Incorporated, 450 Westbury Avenue, Carle Place, New York 11514, in the amount of \$331,000.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, that as set forth in the Contract No. 15-222 bid specifications this contract is for a term of three (3) years with one two (2) year renewal at the discretion of the County; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this contract is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
