RE: Request for authority for the County of Westchester to enter into an Agreement with Westchester Jewish Community Services, Inc. to provide Case Management Services for Home-Delivered Meals Assessments under the Community Services for the Elderly Act Program, in an amount not to exceed \$115,000, comprised of \$85,000 in State funds and \$30,000 in County funds, for the program period April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2017.

The County of Westchester (the "County") acting by and through its Department of Senior Programs and Services (the "Department") seeks the authority of your Honorable Board to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement") with Westchester Jewish Community Services, Inc. (the "Contractor") to provide Case Management Services for Home-Delivered Meals Assessments under the Community Services for the Elderly Act Program (the "Program") in an amount not to exceed \$115,000, comprised of \$85,000 in State funds and \$30,000 in County funds, payable at the unit cost amount of \$38 for the period commencing on April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2017. The County at its sole option may renew the Agreement with the Contractor for up to two (2) additional one (1) year periods subject to the prior approval of your Honorable Board.

The Agreement with the Contractor will serve a public purpose because at risk seniors will be evaluated to ensure the continuity of supportive services tailored to their specific needs. Thereby, allowing them to remain in their homes and communities, thus delaying institutionalization.

The goals and objectives are to conduct comprehensive initial home visit assessments and reassessments for at risk homebound elderly Westchester County residents to determine their needs and to satisfy their basic need for food, nutrition and socialization. Reassessments will be conducted at least annually or more often on an as needed basis. The home delivered meals program specifically aims to maintain or improve the well-being of those seniors who are at increased nutritional risk.

The goals and objectives of the Agreement are in the County's best interests in terms of fiscal responsibility as they will enable seniors to remain in their homes and communities, to maintain a cost-effective lifestyle, and reduce or delay nursing home institutionalization; thereby, reducing Medicaid costs for the County, state and federal governments and improving the general well-being of the County's elderly.

The goals and objectives will be tracked, monitored and evaluated by the Department to ensure compliance with County Regulations. Annual on-site monitoring will be completed by the Department

The Agreement with the Contractor is exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3(a) xix thereof.

Accordingly, I most respectfully recommend adoption of the attached proposed resolution.

RESOLUTION

Upon communication from the Commissioner of the Westchester County Department of Senior Programs and Services, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (the "County") acting by and through its Department of Senior Programs & Services (the "Department") is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement") with Westchester Jewish Community Services, Inc. (the "Contractor") to provide Case Management Services for Home-Delivered Meals Assessments under the Community Services for the Elderly Program (the "Program") in an amount not to exceed \$115,000, comprised of \$85,000 in State funds and \$30,000 in County funds, payable at the unit cost amount of \$38, for the period commencing on April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2017; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County at its sole option may renew the Agreement with the Contractor for up to two (2) additional one (1) year periods subject to the prior approval of your Honorable Board; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Agreement with the Contractor is subject to County Appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoptions(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate the Agreement or to renegotiate the amount and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate the Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee be, and hereby is, authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
