RE: First Amendment to Contract No. **EF-1509**
Authorization to extend the term of Agreement between the County of Westchester and Fred A. Cook, Jr., Inc. until August 31, 2016 at no additional cost.

On December 18, 2015, Contract No. EF-1509 was executed between the County of Westchester and, Fred A. Cook, Jr., Inc. ("Cook") for the internal inspection of the influent trunk sewers at the Blind Brook Wastewater Treatment Plant, Westchester County, New York, in the amount of \$92,750.00. The contract duration was originally scheduled for a term ending on June 1, 2016.

The County has been satisfied with the quality of services provided to date. An extension of time is being requested because the Contractor did not anticipate the increased workload he experienced due to the mild winter and spring of 2016. The warmer weather and lack of snow caused a backlog of work at his business, and he was unable to start the work as early as he had anticipated. The attached Resolution for Amendment No. 1 has been prepared to extend the contract end date and will provide the Contractor additional time to complete all of original contract work.

The attached resolution is requesting for an extension of the agreement until August 31, 2016, with no increase in the not to exceed amount of \$92,750.00. The time extension is requested, for the provision of completing all the required contract work in connection with the internal inspection of the influent trunk sewers at the Blind Brook Wastewater Treatment Plant with no additional cost.

The intent of this amendment is to allow the Contractor sufficient time to complete the entire scope of contract work. Department representatives will continue to track and monitor the Contractor's work and verify the work is in accordance with the contract documents. This Contract is deemed to fulfill a public purpose as the services provided under this Contract protect the building and facilities owned by the Department of Environmental Facilities and enable the Department to carry out its basic mission to provide wastewater treatment and maintain satisfactory water quality.

Approval by the Board of Acquisition and Contract is respectfully requested.
