SUBJECT: Authority to enter into an agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) in order to accept a grant in the amount of \$329,915 to be used to implement the Stepping Stones program under HUD’s Continuum of Care Program and utilize a portion of those grant funds to enter into an Agreement with Children’s Village, Inc. to provide a transitional housing program for homeless young adults between the ages of 18 and 24 for the period from December 1, 2016 through November 30, 2017 in an amount not-to-exceed \$319,124, pursuant to an approved budget.

Authority is respectfully requested from your Honorable Board for the County of Westchester (the “County”), acting by and through its Department of Social Services (the “Department”), to enter into an agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) in order to accept a Continuum of Care Program grant (Grant No. NY0864L2T041504) in the amount of \$329,915 (“Grant”). Authority is further requested to enter into an Agreement with Children’s Village, Inc. (“Children’s Village”) to utilize a portion of the Grant funds to provide a Continuum of Care program entitled Stepping Stones for up to twelve homeless young adults between the ages of 18 and 24 for the period from December 1, 2016 through November 30, 2017 in an amount not-to-exceed \$319,124, pursuant to an approved budget (the “Agreement”). The County will retain \$10,791 from the grant as administrative cost.

I certify that my department, a) has copies of, or access to, all applicable laws, rules, regulations, grant applications, and grant agreements (including any master grant agreement), as well as any guidance or instructions received from the agency making the grant (the “Grant Terms”), b) has reviewed the Grant Terms, c) is aware of and understands all of the Grant Terms, and d.) and will comply with all of the Grant Terms.

The grant agreement with HUD is not a procurement therefore the provisions of the Westchester County Procurement Policy do not apply.

In 2012, the agreement with Children's Village was awarded pursuant to a Request for Proposals ("RFP") which was issued in September of 2012 by the Westchester County Partnership for the Homeless which coordinates the consolidated grant application annually to HUD's Continuum of Care for the Homeless program on behalf of the County, the City of Yonkers, the City of Mount Vernon, the City of New Rochelle and the City of White Plains. Because this is a Renewal Grant, the Federal funding for this program is exempt from the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (formerly, the Grants Management Common Rule) and may be renewed on a non-competitive basis pursuant to 24 CFR 583.235(a).

The proposed agreement will serve a **public purpose** by providing transitional housing program for 12 young adults ages 18-24 who are homeless as defined by HUD homeless criteria.

The goals and objectives of the proposed agreement are to provide transitional housing to help homeless adults avoid dependency on social services, and develop the skills necessary to increase their chances at moving toward self-sufficiency.

The goals and objectives of the proposed agreement are in the best interests of the County in terms of fiscal responsibility, as the proposed agreement will make available to the County the funds necessary to implement the aforementioned program. The goals and objectives of the proposed agreement are also in the best interests of the County in terms of both fiscal responsibility and public health and safety as the programs funded by the proposed agreement will be aimed at ensuring the well being and safety of the targeted population and addressing the issues of homelessness and welfare dependency in the County which can reduce the costs associated with social services provided by the County.

The goals and objectives of the proposed agreement will be tracked and monitored by the Department in accordance with the requirements of HUD. The Department will be required to submit Annual Progress Reports to HUD as a requirement of receiving the funding to be provided under the proposed agreement. These multi-page Annual Progress Reports capture statistical data on those served, the various categories they fall into, the milestones reached, the money expended, etc., which must match the program outlined in the Department's Technical Submission.

I respectfully recommend your Honorable Board's approval of the attached Resolution.

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (the “County”), acting by and through its Department of Social Services, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) in order to accept a grant in the amount of \$329,915 (Grant No. NY0864L2T041504) and to enter into an agreement with Children’s Village, Inc. (“Children’s Village”) to provide Stepping Stones, a transitional housing program for up to twelve homeless young adults between the ages of 18 and 24 for the period from December 1, 2016 through November 30, 2017 pursuant to HUD’s Supportive Housing Program in an amount not to exceed \$319,124, pursuant to an approved budget; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive, or his authorized designee, is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
