On October 19, 2016 six (6) bids were received and opened for Contract No. BOE 16-08 for 2017 and 2018 Primary, Special and General Election Moving Services of Voting Machines, Supply Bags and Privacy Booths between the County Warehouse and Various Polling Place Locations in Westchester County ZONE 2 - Bedford, Lewisboro, Mount Kisco, New Castle, North Salem and Pound Ridge.

The bids were reviewed by the County Board of Elections and it was determined that Liffey Van Lines, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$97,503.00. Pursuant to the bid specifications, the County-wide voting machine moving work was separated into six (6) contracts and zones, no bidder could be awarded more than three (3) out of the six (6) contracts and zones, and Liffey Van Lines, Inc. submitted the low bid in four (4) contracts and three (3) zones. Therefore, authority is hereby requested to award Contract No. BOE 16-08 to the low bidder, Liffey Van Lines, Inc.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Liffey Van Lines, Inc.

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The public purpose, as well as the goal and objective of this contract, is to allow the Board of Elections to carry out its statutory duties in connection with all upcoming 2017 and 2018 Primary, Special and General Elections and to ensure that all eligible County residents have the opportunity to exercise their right to vote. County Board of Elections staff will monitor the contractor's performance of the contract.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. BOE 16-08 be awarded to Liffey Van Lines, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$97,503.00, subject to appropriations and payable pursuant to an approved budget.

WHEREAS, Liffey Van Lines, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$97,503.00 however, pursuant to the bid specifications, the County-wide voting machine moving work was separated into six (6) contracts and zones, no bidder could be awarded more than three (3) out of the six (6) contracts and zones, and Liffey Van Lines, Inc. submitted the low bid in four (4) contracts and zones; and

RESOLVED, that Contract No. BOE 16-08 for 2017 and 2018 Primary, Special and General Election Moving Services of Voting Machines, Supply Bags and Privacy Booths between the County Warehouse and Various Polling Place Locations in Westchester County ZONE 1 - - Bedford, Lewisboro, Mount Kisco, New Castle, North Salem and Pound Ridge be and is hereby awarded to the low bidder, Liffey Van Lines, Inc., 121 Stillwater Road, Mahopac, New York 10541, in an amount not to exceed \$97,503.00, payable pursuant to an approved budget; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this contract is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
