SUBJECT: Resolution to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy, pursuant to Section 3(a)(xxi) thereof, an agreement with each of forty-six (46) entities, pursuant to which each entity will provide community mental health services, for the period from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2021.

Authority is hereby requested from your Honorable Board to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures (the "Procurement Policy") an agreement with each of the forty-six (46) entities listed below (collectively, the "Proposed Agreements"), pursuant to which each entity will provide community mental health services, for the period from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2021:

A few months ago, the County inquired with the New York State Office of Mental Health (“OMH”) as to how it should proceed with the procurement of new agreements for community health services—to be paid for with money provided through OMH—to replace its current agreements for such services, which will expire on December 31, 2016 (the “Current Agreements”). Specifically, the County inquired as to the particular procurement rules with which OMH would ultimately direct and require the County to comply, given the details regarding the funding sources, types of services, and target populations that are involved in such agreements. In his subsequent response, the Director of OMH’s Hudson River Field Office wrote (in pertinent part) the following:

“Many counties, like Westchester, are looking at the current awards for services and determining whether to continue with existing providers or to "re-bid" these services. NYS OMH also faced the same situation. It was determined, following discussions with the Office of the State Comptroller, that due to the nature of the contract, services to individuals living with Mental Illness, that certain contracts should remain with the existing contractors. These legacy contracts remain with the existing providers to allow for continuity of care and maintain health and safety for individuals receiving mental health services....”

The Director also wrote, near the end of his response, that “[u]ltimately, the County needs to follow their contracting guidelines.”

Just as is apparently the case for OMH’s own contracts for community mental health services, the County’s Current Agreements are with well-established and long-standing providers of such services. Accordingly, the County has reached the same conclusion as OMH: continuing to contract with existing providers of these community mental health services allows for continuity of care for a vulnerable population, which ultimately helps maintain the health and safety of such persons.

Therefore, it is proposed that the best interests of the County would be served by exempting the Proposed Agreements from the Procurement Policy, pursuant to Section 3(a)(xxi) thereof. Therefore, a resolution to exempt the procurement of the Proposed Agreements is hereby submitted for your consideration.
