SUBJECT: Authority to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures an agreement with Steven Sledzik, Esq. for the provision of administrative hearing officer services on behalf of the Westchester County Solid Waste Commission, for a term commencing March 1, 2017 and continuing through February 28, 2018, in an amount not-to-exceed \$20,000.00.

Authority is hereby requested from your Honorable Board to exempt from the procedures of the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures (the "Procurement Policy") an agreement between the County of Westchester (the "County") and Steven Sledzik, Esq. for Mr. Sledzik to provide administrative hearing officer services on behalf of the Westchester County Solid Waste Commission (the "Commission"), for a term commencing March 1, 2017 and continuing through February 28, 2018, in an amount not-to-exceed amount \$20,000.00, and payable pursuant to an approved budget.

Mr. Sledzik has previously provided administrative hearing officer services to the Commission and his current agreement will expire on February 28, 2017.

The exemption is in the County's best interest regarding public health and safety since Mr. Sledzik possesses substantive knowledge of the laws, rules and regulations governing Commission hearings and the daily practices and procedures of the solid waste and recycling industry (the "Industry") within the County. This knowledge and experience enables Mr. Sledzik to conduct hearings and to render recommendation reports to the Commission with far greater competency and nuanced insight than individuals who have not previously served as a Commission Administrative Hearing Officer. Furthermore, this acquired insight is integral to the Commission's obligation to provide and regulate Industry licensees within a fair legal forum, while simultaneously pursuing its legislative mandate to eliminate unlawful conduct within the Industry.

The exemption is also in the County's best interest regarding fiscal responsibility since Mr. Sledzik's experience as a Commission Hearing Officer enables him to efficiently conduct

administrative hearings, thereby reducing County expenses through reduced time billings. Mr. Sledzik's continuation as a Commission Hearing Officer is additionally in the County's best interest regarding public safety and fiscal responsibility since his experience will help to ensure that Commission decisions are properly rendered to withstand potential Article 78 proceedings and thereby limiting the County's potential monetary liability resulting from the same.

Therefore, it is proposed that the County's best interests would be served by exempting the aforementioned agreement with Mr. Sledzik from the County's Procurement Policy procedures pursuant to Section 3(a)(xxi) thereof.

Accordingly, a resolution to exempt this procurement is hereby submitted for your Honorable Board's consideration.
