On April 19, 2017, six (6) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 10-511 for Rehabilitation of the Bowman Avenue Bridge (BIN 3358500) over Blind Brook, Town of Harrison, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Gianfia Corp. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$503,776.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Gianfia Corp.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to repair substandard structural elements of the Bowman Avenue Bridge.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
