RE: Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to extend a Grant Agreement (Upstate Quality Improvement and Caseload Reduction Grant also known as Contract #C000655) with the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services with an original term commencing January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2016 to a new termination date of December 31, 2017, and to extend an Agreement with The Legal Aid Society of Westchester County and the Westchester County Bar Association for the same purpose.

On May 21, 2015 your Honorable Board approved a resolution authorizing the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into a Grant Agreement (the "Grant Agreement") for an Upstate Quality Improvement and Caseload Reduction Grant (Contract #C000655) with the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services ("OILS") for the receipt of up to \$258,344.00 to improve the quality of indigent legal services provided by the County for the period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2016 and to enter into an Agreement with The Legal Aid Society of Westchester County and the Westchester County Bar Association to implement the County's indigent legal services work plan for the aforesaid grant for the period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2016. The Grant Agreement and the Agreement were subsequently executed.

The Legal Aid Society of Westchester County, on behalf of the County requested an extension of the Grant Agreement from OILS to complete the work plan associated with the Grant Agreement and an extension has been approved by OILS through December 31, 2017. Authority is being requested herein to execute the extension of the Grant Agreement with OILS and to execute an extension of the Agreement between the County and The Legal Aid Society of Westchester County and the Westchester County Bar Association for the same purpose.

The extension of the term of the Grant Agreement and the Agreement will continue to serve a public purpose in that it will enable the County to fulfill and improve its lawful obligation of providing counsel to certain indigent persons. The goals and objectives are to ensure that effective counsel is provided in a cost efficient manner.

The extension of the Grant Agreement with OILS is exempt from the County's procurement policy pursuant to Section 3(a)iii. The extension of the Agreement with The Legal Aid Society of Westchester and the Westchester County Bar Association is exempt from the County's procurement policy pursuant to Sections 3(a)xi and 3(a)xiv.

Accordingly, attached herewith is a resolution authorizing an extension of the Grant Agreement with OILS and the Agreement with The Legal Aid Society of Westchester County and the Westchester County Bar Association through December 31, 2017. No County funds will be expended for this purpose.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the County Attorney, be it

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester be and is hereby authorized to amend a grant agreement previously executed by the County and the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services for the Upstate Quality Improvement and Caseload Reduction Grant (Contract #C000655) in the amount of \$258,344.00 (the "Grant Agreement") to improve the quality of indigent legal services provided by the County for the period January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2016 to extend the termination date from December 31, 2016 to December 31, 2017; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester be and is hereby authorized to amend an agreement previously executed by the County and The Legal Aid Society of Westchester County and the Westchester County Bar Association to execute the workplan in connection with the Upstate Quality Improvement and Caseload Reduction Grant for the period January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2016 (the "Agreement") to extend the termination date to December 31, 2017; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the amendment to the Grant Agreement and the amendment to the Agreement shall be at no cost to the County; and be it further

RESOLVED, that all other terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement and Agreement shall remain the same; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive, or his duly authorized designee, is empowered to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the purposes herein.
