The 2017 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to provide finalization of the exterior performance maintenance needs at the Blind Brook Wastewater Treatment Plant including complete splitter box installation work and associated electrical improvements. Additionally, work will include miscellaneous electrical improvements throughout the Control Building, Rye Maintenance Building and the Sludge Pump Building.

In accordance with Chapter 635 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this contract is to provide improvements including increased efficiency and reliability of equipment and redundancy of operation regarding influent flow at the Blind Brook Wastewater Treatment Plant.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it protects plant equipment, provides improved plant operability and reliability, and ensures that the plant's operations are safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
