On June 28, 2017, four (4) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 17-504 for Roof Replacement, Penitentiary I-Block, Norwood E. Jackson Correctional Center, Valhalla Campus, Valhalla, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Sony NY Management & Construction Corp. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$396,521.35.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Sony NY Management & Construction Corp.:
