The 2017 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to upgrade the North Yonkers Pump Station including replacement of the three influent coarse bar screens, installation of new washer/compactor units, replacement of the grit handling system, and structural, architectural, electrical and instrumentation improvements.

In accordance with Chapter 635 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this contract is to upgrade various components of the North Yonkers Pump Station and provide flood mitigation measures.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it protects equipment, provides improved operability and reliability, and ensures that operations are safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
