Re: Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester, acting by and through Westchester Community College, to enter into a grant agreement with the State of New York, acting by and through its Department of Labor, whereby the College will accept grant funds in order to implement a technology and job readiness training program for displaced homemakers for a term of September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2018 for an amount not to exceed \$124,615.

Authority is requested to enter into a grant agreement with the State of New York, acting by and through its Department of Labor, whereby Westchester Community College (the "College") will accept grant funds in order to implement a technology and job readiness training program for displaced homemakers for a term of September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2018 for an amount not to exceed \$124,615.

The grant funds will be used to provide a program consisting of vocationally related training to individuals who have been displaced from their careers as unpaid homemakers. The goal of the program is to help long-term homemakers develop skills and create a transition plan that will lead to employment, allowing them to become economically independent. The grant funds and program will also provide personal career counseling to assist individuals who have lost their financial support and are in transition from unpaid homemaker to the paid workforce, including those who are separated, divorced, widowed or whose spouse is disabled or long-term unemployed.

The agreement shall serve a public purpose since it will enable the College to implement a technology and job readiness training program for displaced homemakers, thereby assisting them to become economically independent. The agreement and the program's results will be monitored by College faculty and personnel.

Accordingly, approval of the annexed proposed Resolution is requested.
