The 2017 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract includes all necessary labor, materials and equipment to remove the existing bridge superstructure, modify the existing abutments for a new pre-stressed concrete slab unit deck with stone faced concrete core parapet walls, removal and replacement of concrete approach slabs, waterproofing the new deck and a new paved wearing surface, repointing existing masonry and adding scour protection at the abutment footings.

The objective of this contract is to repair substandard structural elements of the Elm Street Access Ramp Bridge.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the Elm Street Access Ramp Bridge meets current codes and standards as well as reducing the County's annual maintenance costs.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
