On January 31, 2018, six (6) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 17-543 for Rotating Biological Contactors Upgrade, Phase II-B, Port Chester Wastewater Treatment Plant, Port Chester, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Jett Industries, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$8,269,000.00, and has proposed the utilization of the following subcontractor: Filingeri Electrical Contracting Corp. (Electrical Work), 3510 Lexington Avenue, Mohegan Lake, New York 10547.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Jett Industries, Inc.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to replace the final three existing Rotating Biological Contactor (RBC) trains used for secondary wastewater treatment which have reached the end of their useful life. Of the seven existing RBC trains at the plant, one was replaced in Phase I and three are being replaced in Phase II. In replacing these final three RBC trains, this Phase II-B project will provide the ability to reliably treat wastewater and upgrade the plant for future nitrogen removal as required by the Order-On-Consent with New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it protects equipment, provides improved operability and reliability, and ensures that operations are safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

The Department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 17-543 be awarded to Jett Industries, Inc. in the amount of \$8,269,000.00.
