On January 17, 2018, nine (9) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 10-508 for Rehabilitation of Access Ramp at Elm Street over Bronx River (BIN 3348650), Village of Tuckahoe, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department, and it was determined that Laura Li Industries, LLC submitted the low bid in the amount of \$1,770,615.00.

The low bidder has been investigated, and it has been found that Laura Li Industries, LLC:

The objective of this contract is to repair substandard structural elements of the Elm Street Access Ramp Bridge.
