SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with Bedford Central School District to use the Fox Lane High School from June 26, 2018 through June 28, 2018, during certain designated hours for training and practice exercises in connection with Indian Point Emergency Planning.

The County of Westchester ("County"), acting by and through its Department of Emergency Services, is requesting authority to enter into an agreement with the Bedford Central School District (the "School District") pursuant to which the School District will grant to the County, and the County will accept, a permit to use the School District's premises and facilities located at the Fox Lane High School from June 26, 2018 through June 28, 2018 during certain designated hours in order to conduct training and emergency exercises to demonstrate the operation of a General Population Reception Center as outlined in the Radiological Emergency Plan for Indian Point Nuclear Power Plant.

Under the proposed Agreement, the School District is waiving the permit fee and requesting only that the County defend, indemnify and hold harmless the School District from and against any and all liability, loss, damages, claims, or actions (including costs and attorneys fees) for bodily injury and/or property damage, to the extent permissible by law, arising out of or in connection with the actual or proposed use of School District's property, facilities and/or services.

The proposed Agreement will serve a public purpose by providing the County with a facility to conduct the training and emergency exercises in cooperation with New York State and the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA"). The School District is one of four pre-designated General Population Reception Centers. These sites provide radiological monitoring, decontamination and social services to evacuees. The exercise would involve staff from the

County Departments of Emergency Services, Health and Social Services setting up and staffing a community Reception Center for residents evacuating from the Indian Point Emergency Planning Zone. Evacuees would be simulated. The exercise will be evaluated by the FEMA.

The goals and objectives of the proposed Agreement are in the best interests of the County in terms of public safety and emergency preparedness and play a vital role in bolstering the preparedness levels of the County, the State and FEMA. The public purpose of the proposed agreement is to enhance public safety and general welfare in times of an emergency and will therefore benefit the public good.

The goals and objectives of the proposed Agreement will be tracked and monitored by the staff of the Department of Emergency Services.

This agreement is exempt from the requirements of the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3(b) thereof.

Accordingly, I most respectfully recommend the adoption of the annexed Resolution.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of Emergency Services, be it hereby
