Subject: Authority to amend an agreement with STRIVE International, Inc. to accept a grant in the amount of \$550,000 to provide various workforce development services to youth who are involved with the juvenile justice system and who reside in high poverty and high crime neighborhoods in the City of Yonkers under the *STRIVE Forward in Westchester* program for the program period November 1, 2015 through September 30, 2018, by increasing the grant amount by an additional \$92,000 from \$550,000 to \$642,000 in order to compensate the County for increasing its outcome performance with respect to the number of participants completing the Future Leaders Workshops.

By resolution approved on April 28, 2016, your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Social Services Office of Workforce Investment (the "Department"), on behalf of the Westchester-Putnam Local Workforce Development Board (the "WPLWDB"), to enter into an agreement with STRIVE International, Inc. ("STRIVE") to accept a grant in the amount of \$550,000 (the "Grant") to be used to provide various workforce development services under the *STRIVE Forward in Westchester* program (the "STRIVE Forward Program") for the program period November 1, 2015 through September 30, 2018 (the "Agreement"). The Agreement was subsequently executed.

STRIVE has requested that the County increase its outcome performance with respect to the number of participants completing the Future Leaders Workshops from 78 to 92. The Future Leaders Workshops is an integral part of the STRIVE Forward Program as it provides at risk youth with leadership skills that would help them improve their employability skills. In consideration for providing such additional services, STRIVE has agreed to increase the County's allotment under the Grant by an additional \$92,000. Accordingly, authority is respectfully requested to amend the Agreement with STRIVE to accept a Grant in the amount of \$550,000 to be used to provide various workforce development services under the STRIVE

Forward Program for the program period November 1, 2015 through September 30, 2018, by increasing the Grant amount by an additional \$92,000, from \$550,000 to \$642,000, in order to compensate the County for increasing its outcome performance with respect to the number of participants completing the Future Leaders Workshops from 78 to 92.

That except as specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

The STRIVE Forward Program provides various workforce development services to youth who are involved with the juvenile justice system and who reside in high poverty and high crime neighborhoods in the City of Yonkers. These services include, but are not limited to, case management, mentoring, educational interventions, service learning, occupational training and follow-up services. The Department has subcontracted these services to Westhab, Inc. and other agencies. Approval for these subcontracts has been obtained under separate cover.

Funding for the STRIVE Forward Program is provided by the U.S. Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration. STRIVE is the prime recipient of the grant funds. The County, as a subrecipient of the grant, submitted a competitive proposal to STRIVE and was awarded a portion of the funding.

The Agreement will serve a **public purpose** by assisting adjudicated and at-risk youth complete their education and secure and retain sustainable employment.

The **goals and objectives** of the program are to place eligible youth, from various high crime, high poverty neighborhoods in Westchester County into a program to provide a suite of services centered around STRIVE's Core Attitudinal and Job Readiness Training.

The **goals and objectives** of the Agreement are in the best interests of the County in terms of fiscal responsibility because the participating youth will receive case management, mentoring and restorative justice services to develop them economically and have a dramatic impact on their communities by reducing the impact on the criminal justice system where several of these youth have been involved.

The **goals and objectives** of the Agreement will be tracked and monitored by staff of the Department.

As this is an amendment to an agreement to accept grant funds, the provisions of the Westchester County Procurement Policy do not apply.
