On April 4, 2018, nine (9) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 17-527 for Playground Site Work Rehabilitation, Sprain Ridge Park, Town of Greenburgh and City of Yonkers, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Pat Corsetti, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$312,435.75.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Pat Corsetti, Inc.:

The objective of this contract is to upgrade the existing playground.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by improving the playground to meet current State and Health Department codes and standards.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 17-527 be awarded to Pat Corsetti, Inc. in the amount of \$312,435.75.

RESOLUTION

CONTRACT NO. 17-527

Upon communication from the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation, be it

RESOLVED, that Contract No. 17-527 for Playground Site Work Rehabilitation, Sprain Ridge Park, Town of Greenburgh and City of Yonkers, New York be and is hereby awarded to the low bidder, Pat Corsetti, Inc., 610 Fenimore Road, Mamaroneck, New York 10543 in the amount of \$312,435.75; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
