SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing the amendment to the agreement between the County of Westchester and Hasting-on-Hudson Affordable HDFC to fund the construction of site work and infrastructure improvements all in support of the affordable affirmatively further fair housing development located at 190 Farragut Avenue (formerly known as 184 Farragut Avenue) in the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson, in order to change the expiration date.

On October 30, 2014, your Honorable Board approved a resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement") with Hasting-on-Hudson Affordable HDFC to provide funding in an amount not to exceed \$120,000.00 in Non-County FAH Community Development Block Grant Funds under Capital Project BPL50 to finance construction of certain site/infrastructure improvements in support of the affordable affirmatively further fair housing ("AFFH") development located at 190 Farragut Avenue (formerly known as 184 Farragut Avenue) in the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson, which would commence upon execution and continue for a term of two (2) years.

The parties now desire to amend the Agreement in order change the expiration date from May 17, 2018 to December 31, 2018. The additional time is needed as the severe winter weather and delays in conducting the water pressure test by a contractor have prohibited the progress of the construction of the development.

The goal and objective of this amendment remains to carry out the County's obligations under the Settlement Agreement by constructing affordable AFFH units in accordance with the terms of the Housing Settlement Agreement. In addition, the development will create home ownership and rental opportunities for lower and moderate income individuals and families who may not otherwise be able to afford to purchase or rent a home in Westchester County, which is safe, secure and energy efficient. It will also enhance the neighborhood through its design and landscaping. Department of Planning staff will monitor and track construction, as well as monitor compliance with the affordability requirements.

I recommend approval of this amendment.
