Mamaroneck Wastewater Treatment Plant

On June 7, 2017, four (4) bids were received for Contract No. 11-537 for Primary, Secondary, Heating and Chemical Handling Upgrades, Mamaroneck Wastewater Treatment Plant, Mamaroneck, New York.

Subsequently, a review of the bids determined that all bids were over budget. A capital budget amendment was obtained but the low bidder could not hold their price beyond the 45 days as stated in the bid and it is in the County's best interest to modify the specifications and re-bid.

Therefore, authority is requested to re-advertise as Contract No. 11-537-Rev.

In accordance with Chapter 635 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this contract is to replace and upgrade the primary and secondary process equipment that has reached the end of its useful life to ensure process reliability and environmentally compliant operation of the treatment plant.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will ensure that the plant's operations are safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

This resolution has been reviewed by the Law Department.
