The 2018 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for the replacement of Corten, self-weathering rustic steel guide railing at various locations in Westchester County.

The objective of this contract is to install new railings to be constructed to meet current NYSDOT standards.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by meeting American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO) standards for highway safety.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County of Westchester's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further
