RE: Authority to enter into a license agreement with the Village of Ossining ("Village") pursuant to which the Village will, at its sole cost, continue to maintain a "Welcome to Ossining" sign and provide general maintenance on a parcel adjacent to Route 9A in the Village for the period from August 22, 2018 through August 21, 2023.

In 2013, the Village of Ossining erected a "Welcome to Ossining" sign on a small parcel of land adjacent to Route 9A in the Village. Authority is hereby requested for the County of Westchester, acting by and through the Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation, to enter into a license agreement with the Village of Ossining pursuant to which the Village will, at its sole cost, continue to maintain the "Welcome to Ossining" sign and continue to provide general maintenance on the parcel adjacent to Route 9A in the Village for the period of August 22, 2018 through August 21, 2023.

The Village will maintain the parcel so as to keep it presentable and aesthetically pleasing for public view. The Village will assume all risks associated with the maintenance of the property and will defend and indemnify the County for any and all claims, demands or causes of action directly or indirectly arising out of the license.

The subject property is part of land acquired by the Westchester County Park Commission in 1927 for the Briarcliff-Peekskill Parkway. The parkway was never constructed by the Park Commission, but in later years the State Department of Transportation "took" the land to construct NY Route 9A. The land not used for the highway was returned to the County.

The ultimate benefit of this agreement will be for the public good by the beautification of County property by the Village and provide a visual interest to motorists and pedestrians.. This license will be monitored by the Parks Department to ensure compliance with all the terms of the license.

This license agreement is exempt from the County Procurement Policy and Procedures pursuant

to Section 3(b) thereof.

Accordingly, approval of the attached resolution by your Honorable Board is most respectfully requested.
