On August 1, 2018 the County of Westchester (“County”) received and opened two (2) bids for Contract No. 11-557-Rev. for Phase I – Sewer System Rehabilitation, Saw Mill Sanitary Sewer District, Westchester County, New York.

Two (2) contractors submitted bids for this project. The project was advertised on the Empire State Purchasing Group website, in addition to the Journal News (Westchester-Putnam Edition), and was viewed by sixty nine (69) entities on the Empire State Purchasing Group website. In addition, e-mails were sent to those sixty nine (69) entities and to an additional three hundred ninety three (393) suppliers and contractors.

The bids were reviewed by the Department of Public Works and Transportation and it was determined that Green Mountain Pipeline Services LLC submitted the low bid in the amount of \$3,666,611.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Green Mountain Pipeline Services LLC:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to repair identified sources of infiltration, inflow, structural deficiencies, and other physical defects in pipeline and manholes. Pipeline defects may include broken and cracked pipe, separated joints, corrosion, and heavy root intrusion. Manhole defects may include offset frames, broken covers, root intrusion, infiltration, and inflow due to low-lying manholes.

This contract is in the public’s best interest because it effectuates long-term repairs of these critical sewer system components avoiding potential adverse environmental impact to the surrounding properties and water bodies. This work is necessary to provide improved sanitary facilities that are in compliance with all applicable regulations, thereby promoting public health policies and laws.

The Department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 11-557-Rev. be awarded to Green Mountain Pipeline Services LLC in the amount of \$3,666,611.00.
