With Authority to enter into an agreement with Bank of America, ("B of A") for the Re:

provision of certain banking services for a term of three years, with the County having the

sole option to renew the agreement for two additional one year renewal terms.

Transmitted herewith is a resolution which, if approved by your Honorable Board, will authorize the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into an agreement with Bank of America ("B of A") for the provision of certain banking services (the "Services") for a term of three years commencing on April 1, 2019, with the County having the sole option to renew the agreement for two additional one year renewal terms (the "Agreement"). Pursuant to the Agreement

B of A will provide "Money Room/VAULT", PrePaid Card Services, Core Depository services and Escrow services. These services are currently being provided to the County by B of A and have been since 2007. Pursuant to the Agreement, B of A will be compensated through a combination of fees being paid by the County and/or compensating balances. The fees are estimated to be \$15,000 per year regardless of whether they are paid for in compensating balances or in cash. Therefore, the total cost of this component of the Agreement is estimated to be \$45,000 for the three year term. This cost will be recorded as an offset to Interest Income. Additionally, the inclusion of an armored car transportation component is being included in this banking services agreement request. Currently transportation services are provided to various Parks and Recreation and Conservation facilities at the approximate rate of \$79 per pick up. The pricing under the proposed Agreement will be approximately \$55 per pick up, which will result in significant savings to the Department of Parks Recreation and Conservation. It is estimated that yearly transportation costs pursuant to the new Agreement will be approximately \$36,098 per year. Therefore, the total estimated cost of the three year Agreement is \$153,294.

The County originally entered into agreements with B of A for banking services on September 27, 2007 which extended through March 31, 2014. In mid 2013 the Department of Finance (the "Department") began discussing the possibility of continuing B of A's relationship with the County. Through negotiations undertaken by the Department, a new, more competitive pricing structure was agreed upon with more advantageous pricing for the County. A new

contract was executed on April 1, 2014 with a termination date (after renewals) of March 31, 2019. The County again approached B of A about the possibility of continuing the relationship in late 2018. Bank of America is now offering the County substantially unchanged pricing on the Banking Services being renewed and very competitive rates on the new Transportation component.

The current agreement with B of A expires on March 31, 2019, and, based upon the entirety of the expired agreement as well as the very good service the County has received in the last twelve (12) years I recommend that the County enter into this new Agreement with B of A.

The goal and objective of this agreement is to receive cost efficient delivery of banking/transportation services necessary for the operation of the County. The Department will monitor B of A's performance through regular reports and bank statements.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of Finance, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester ("County") is authorized to enter into an agreement with Bank of America for the term April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2022 (the "Agreement") to provide certain banking and transportation services (the "Services"), with the County having the sole option to renew the agreement for two additional one year renewal terms.

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute any documents and take any actions reasonably necessary and appropriate to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution
