RE: Request authority for the County of Westchester to enter into a grant agreement with the New York State Office for the Aging in an amount not to exceed \$653,982 to provide information services to individuals of all ages with long term care needs under the NY Connects Expansion and Enhancement Program, for the program period April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020.

The County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Senior Programs and Services (the "Department"), seeks authority from your Honorable Board to enter into a grant agreement with the New York State Office for the Aging ("NYSOFA") in an amount not to exceed \$653,982 to provide information services to individuals of all ages with long term care needs under the NY Connects Expansion and Enhancement Program ("NY Connects Program"). The agreement shall commence on April 1, 2019 and continue through March 31, 2020 (the "NYSOFA Agreement").

Of the \$653,982 in funding, \$34,160 will be used to enter into Inter-departmental Cooperative Memoranda with Westchester County Department of Social Services and Westchester County Office for the Disabled and as such do not require the approval of your Honorable Board. The remaining \$619,822 will be used by the Department to provide information contacts.

NY Connects Program is a State program that aims to improve access to Long-Term Services and Supports ("LTSS"). It connects older adults and individuals of any age with disabilities, as well as their caregivers, in need of LTSS with the necessary services and supports regardless of available payment source, be it private pay, public or a combination of both. It minimizes confusion, supports informed decision-making and enhances consumer choice.

The proposed NYSOFA Agreement will serve a public purpose because it provides funding which allows for a no wrong door for providing consistent coordinated and objective information and assistance on long term care services and supports through the NY Connects Program.

The goals and objectives of the NY Connects Program are to build on the current efforts to rebalance the delivery of long term services and supports to seniors and to improve access to non-institutional long term services and supports.

The goals and objectives of the NY Connects Program are fiscally in the best interests of the County because they serve to delay or divert seniors from institutionalization, thereby reducing Medicaid costs to the County.

The goals and objectives of the NY Connects Program will be tracked, monitored and evaluated by the Department, to ensure compliance with Federal, State and County regulations.

The NYOSFA Agreement does not constitute procurement and as such is not subject to the requirements of the Westchester County Procurement Policy.

I certify that my department, a.) has copies of, or access to, all applicable laws, rules, regulations, grant applications, and grant agreements (including any master grant agreement), as well as any guidance or instructions received from the agency making the grant (the "Grant Terms"), b.) has reviewed the Grant Terms, c.) is aware of and understands all of the Grant Terms, and d.) can and will comply with all of the Grant Terms.

Accordingly, I most respectfully recommend adoption of the attached proposed resolution.
