SUBJECT: **Request for authority for the County of Westchester (“County”) to enter into an agreement with Adirondack Scenic, Inc. d/b/a Adirondack Studios, Inc. (“Adirondack”) pursuant to which Adirondack will complete repair work to design elements of the Dragon Coaster at the County’s Playland Park located in Rye, New York (“Playland”) for a term from July 29, 2019 through July 28, 2020 for an amount not to exceed \$73,365.**

The attached Resolution requests authority for the County to enter into an agreement (“Agreement”) with Adirondack pursuant to which Adirondack will complete repair work to design elements of the Dragon Coaster at Playland (“Work”) for a term from July 29, 2019 through July 28, 2020 for an amount not to exceed \$73,365, payable in installments, as sections of the project are completed.

The Dragon Coaster ride at Playland contains a tunnel which has affixed to its surface decorative details that make the tunnel resemble a dragon, in line with the name of the ride. Repair work is currently needed on the head, lower outer jaw, front leg, wings, body and tail of the Dragon. Work includes but is not limited to; filling surface cracks, patching and sealing holes, reinforcing plywood backings, securing of fin brackets and paint touch-up.

The Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation (the “Department”) complied with the Westchester County Procurement Policy by soliciting proposals for the Work. On April 25, 2019, the Department issued the following Request for Proposals (“RFP”):

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
REPAIR WORK TO DESIGN ELEMENTS OF THE DRAGON COASTER
AT PLAYLAND AMUSEMENT PARK
PLAYLAND PARKWAY
RYE, NEW YORK 10580

The sole proposal received was from Adirondack. The County entered into negotiations with Adirondack and now wishes to enter into an Agreement with Adirondack to complete the Work. Adirondack originally designed and fabricated the thematic elements on the Dragon Coaster fifteen years ago. Their institutional knowledge of how it is constructed, mounted and finished makes them the best choice to now perform repairs and upgrades to the elements.

The goals and objectives shall be tracked and monitored by the staff of the Department.

Accordingly, I most respectfully recommend the adoption of the annexed proposed resolution.

RESOLUTION

Upon a written communication from the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Conservation, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (“County”) is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Adirondack Scenic, Inc. d/b/a Adirondack Studios, Inc. (“Adirondack”) pursuant to which Adirondack will complete repair work to design elements of the Dragon Coaster at the County’s Playland Park located in Rye, New York (“Playland”) for a term from July 29, 2019 through July 28, 2020 for an amount not to exceed \$73,365, payable in installments, as sections of the project are completed; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the “State Budget”) proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed budget of the State of New York and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and after the County has a reasonable period of time to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such budget(s) on County finances, to terminate the agreement authorized herein or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby empowered to execute any and all instruments and take such other actions as may be reasonably necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
