On June 12, 2019, the County of Westchester ("County") received and opened one (1) bid for Contract No. WCA 19003 for Line Striping and Runway Rubber Removal, Westchester County Airport, Towns of Harrison and North Castle and Village of Rye Brook, New York.

One (1) contractor submitted a bid for this project. The project was advertised on the Empire State Purchasing Group website, in addition to the Journal News (Westchester-Putnam Edition), and was viewed by fourteen (14) entities on the Empire State Purchasing Group website. In addition, e-mails were sent to those fourteen (14) entities and to an additional three hundred and one (301) suppliers and contractors.

The bid was reviewed by the Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department") and it was determined that Safety Marking, Inc. submitted the sole bid in the amount of \$857,385.00.

The sole bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Safety Marking, Inc.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to maintain the runways, taxiways, and related infrastructure in a proper condition for the safe operation of aircraft and the traveling public.

This contract is in the public's best interest by maintaining a safe airfield in compliance with Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") regulations.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and Department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

Payment for this contract will be made from the Airport Special Revenue Fund, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.

This contract is for a term of three (3) years with one, two (2) year renewal at the discretion of the County.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. WCA 19003 be awarded to Safety Marking, Inc. in the not to exceed amount of \$857,385.00.
