RE: Authority to amend an agreement with the New York State STOP-DWI Foundation pursuant to which the Foundation agreed to reimburse the County of Westchester in an amount not-to-exceed \$34,500.00 to run special enforcement details that will conduct high visibility road checks, saturation patrols, and drug recognition expert call outs for a term commencing on October 1, 2018 and continuing through September 30, 2019, by increasing the not-to-exceed amount thereunder by an additional \$8,000.00 from \$34,500.00 to \$42,500.00.

By resolution approved on November 21, 2018, your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester (“County”), acting by and through the Department of Public Safety Services (the “Department”), STOP-DWI Office (“STOP DWI Office”) to, *inter alia*, enter into an agreement with the New York State STOP-DWI Foundation, a not-for-profit agency (“the Foundation”), pursuant to which the Foundation agreed to reimburse the County in an amount not-to-exceed \$34,500.00 to be used to run special enforcement details that will conduct high visibility road checks, saturation patrols, and drug recognition expert call outs for a term commencing on October 1, 2018 and continuing through September 30, 2019 (the “Reimbursement Agreement”). The Reimbursement Agreement was subsequently executed.

By letter dated June 10, 2019, the STOP DWI Office was notified by the Foundation that effective June 10, 2019, the Foundation would increase the County’s allotted crackdown money by an additional \$8,000.00. Accordingly, authority is requested to amend the Reimbursement Agreement with the Foundation pursuant to which the Foundation agreed to reimburse the County an amount not-to-exceed \$34,500.00 to run special enforcement details that will conduct high visibility road checks, saturation patrols, and drug recognition expert call outs for a term commencing on October 1, 2018 and continuing through September 30, 2019, by increasing the not-to-exceed amount authorized thereunder by an additional \$8,000.00, from an amount not-to-exceed \$34,500.00 to a new amount not-to-exceed \$42,500.00.

Except as specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions of the Reimbursement Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

The Reimbursement Agreement with the Foundation does not constitute a procurement and as such is not subject to the requirements of the County Procurement Policy.

I certify that my department, a) has copies of, or access to all applicable laws, rules, regulations, reimbursement applications, and the Reimbursement Agreement (including any master agreement), as well as any guidance or instructions received from the Foundation, b), has reviewed the terms of the Reimbursement Agreement, c) is aware of and understands all of the Special Enforcement Program Terms, and d) can and will comply with all of the Special Enforcement Program Terms.

The goals and objectives of the Reimbursement Agreement are to reduce the number of deaths and injuries in the County caused by intoxicated or drugged drivers. The Reimbursement Agreement is in the public's best interest as it will reduce the number of DWI and drugged driving deaths and injuries.

Based upon the foregoing, I most respectfully recommend approval of the attached Resolution.

Upon a communication from Commissioner-Sheriff of Public Safety, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (“County”), acting by and through the Department of Public Safety Services, STOP-DWI Office, is authorized to amend an agreement with the New York State STOP-DWI Foundation, a not-for-profit agency (“the Foundation”), pursuant to which the Foundation agreed to reimburse the County in an amount not-to-exceed \$34,500.00 to be used to run special enforcement details that will conduct high visibility road checks, saturation patrols, and drug recognition expert call-outs for a term commencing on October 1, 2018 and continuing through September 30, 2019 (the “Reimbursement Agreement”), by increasing the not-to-exceed amount authorized thereunder by an additional \$8,000.00, from an amount not-to-exceed \$34,500.00 to a new amount not-to-exceed \$42,500.00; and be it further
