RE: Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into an agreement with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services ("NYSDCJS") pursuant to which the County will accept a grant in an amount not to exceed \$69,972 under the Gun Involved Violence Elimination Initiative ("Project GIVE") program for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, pursuant to an approved budget.

Authority is hereby requested for the County, acting by and through its Department of Public Safety (the "Department"), to enter into an agreement with the NYSDCJS, pursuant to which the County will accept a grant in an amount not to exceed \$69,972 under the Project GIVE program for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, pursuant to an approved budget.

The goal of Project GIVE is to eliminate shootings and homicides through the integrated use of evidence-based strategies that include the four core elements of People, Places, Alignment and Engagement. The objective is to implement a joint agency initiative to directly combat shootings and homicides in Yonkers and Mount Vernon with support and assistance from other law enforcement agencies. The Department will assign personnel to deploy targeted operations as outlined in the Project GIVE strategy through joint agency initiatives. The funds received from NYSDCJS will enable the Department to assign personnel to support Project GIVE strategies in Yonkers and Mount Vernon.

This contract impacts the County's critical priority areas in the following manner:

- Fiscal Responsibility – The County will receive reimbursement for activities performed by the Department pursuant to Project GIVE.

This contract will serve a public purpose by promoting public safety through the implementation of operations under Project GIVE.

I certify that my department, a) has copies of, or access to, all applicable laws, rules, regulations, grant applications, and grant agreements (including any master grant agreement), as well as any guidance or instructions received from the agency making the grant (the "Grant Terms"), b) has reviewed the Grant Terms, c) is aware of and understands all of the Grant Terms, and d) can and will comply with all of the Grant Terms.

Accordingly, authority is respectfully sought for the County to enter this agreement.
