The 2020 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to rehabilitate deficient pipelines through cleaning, television inspection, and cured-in-place lining and deficient manholes by cementitious lining, raising to grade and replacing covers at various locations on the County's Trunk Sewer System in the Various Sanitary Sewer Districts including Blind Brook, Mamaroneck, New Rochelle, Ossining, Peekskill and Yonkers.

The objective of this contract is to repair identified sources of infiltration, inflow, structural deficiencies, and other physical defects in pipeline and manholes. Pipeline defects may include broken and cracked pipe, separated joints, corrosion, and heavy root intrusion. Manhole defects may include offset frames, broken covers, root intrusion, infiltration, and inflow due to low-lying manholes.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it effectuates long-term repairs of these critical sewer system components avoiding potential adverse environmental impact to the surrounding properties and water bodies. This work is necessary to provide improved sanitary facilities that are in compliance with all applicable regulations, thereby promoting public health policies and laws.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
