RE: **Authority to enter into an agreement with the Hudson River Museum of Westchester for the provision of various artistic, cultural and educational programs to the public and to schools throughout the County for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$723,529.00 payable pursuant to an approved budget**

Authority is requested for your Honorable Board for the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into an agreement with the Hudson River Museum of Westchester (the "Museum"), pursuant to which the Museum will provide various artistic, cultural and educational programs including planetarium and science activities and exhibitions to the public and to schools throughout the county for the period commencing January 1, 2020 and continuing through December 31, 2020. In consideration for services rendered, the County will pay the Museum an amount not to exceed \$723,529.00, pursuant to an approved budget, in quarterly installments (the "Agreement").

The Agreement will serve a public purpose by enhancing the quality of life for County residents as well as visitors from outside the County, through a wide array of high quality cultural and educational programming and exhibits including planetarium programs.

The goals and objectives of the Agreement are to provide cultural, artistic and educational experiences offered by the Museum to the residents of the County. The Agreement will serve a public purpose by enhancing the quality of life for County residents as well as visitors from outside the County, through a wide array of high quality cultural and educational programming and exhibits including planetarium programs. The goals and objectives under this Agreement, include, but are not limited to, the following:

The Agreement will serve approximately 73,000 patrons, as follows:

The Museum will host approximately 250 school, community and summer camp group visits, for school aged children who will receive docent-led tours of the gallery and/or attend hands-on workshops taught by staff instructors; and the HRMW will continue its partnerships with private, parochial schools and public schools in Yonkers, offering students various curriculum-related programming both at the Museum and at off-site locations. All told, approximately 25,000 school aged children will benefit from these visits.

The Museum will host approximately 25 visits for adult groups from senior centers, assisted living facilities and community organizations, which will receive gallery tours and/or attend planetarium shows. Approximately 500 adults will benefit from these visits.

The Museum will open 6 exhibitions, from an exhibition of paintings by Hudson River School legendary founder Thomas Cole to the work of Derrick Adams, an acclaimed New York based multidisciplinary artist who presents a joyful view of contemporary Black life and culture, filling the many voids and omissions in popular visual culture. In addition, the Museum will continue to exhibit its permanent collection, including a new special collection spotlight on baseball cards. The Museum will also continue its partnership with Art Bridges, exhibiting major works of 20th century American art on long-term loan alongside permanent works from the Museum's collection.

The Museum amphitheater will continue to entertain approximately 3,000 visitors from the surrounding community and the county who come for free high quality live music, Shakespeare, comedy, and movies.

The Museum planetarium will continue to educate and inspire the approximately 12,000 visitors who attend the public shows.

The Museum will continue to remain open to the public Wednesdays through Sundays every week of the year, receiving approximately 25,000 general admission visitors.

Quarterly and annual performance reports will be submitted to the County Executive's Office by the Museum which will enable the County to track the progress of the Museum in meeting the established goals and objectives of this program.

The Agreement is exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3(a) xiii thereof.

Authority for the County to enter into the Agreement with the Museum for the purposes as herein described is most respectfully requested.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Deputy County Executive, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (the "County") is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Hudson River Museum of Westchester for the provision of various artistic, cultural and educational programs including planetarium and science activities and exhibitions to the public and to schools throughout the county for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, for an amount not to exceed \$723,529.00, pursuant to an approved budget, payable in quarterly installments pursuant to an approved budget (the "Agreement"); and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Agreement is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is authorized to execute said agreement and all documents necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
