RE: Request for authority for the County of Westchester to:

- a) enter into an agreement with the New York State Office for the Aging (“NYSOFA”) to accept a grant in the amount of \$19,611 to provide various support services to caregivers of elderly Westchester County residents 60 years and older under the Caregiver Resource Center program, for the program period April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021; and
- b) amend and agreement with Westchester Jewish Community Services, Inc. to provide various support services to caregivers of elderly Westchester County residents 60 years and older under the Caregiver Resource Center program in order to exercise the first of four (4) one-year option terms. State funding for the program period commencing on April 1, 2020 and continuing through March 31, 2021 shall be for an amount not to exceed \$19,611; and
- c) further amend the agreement to incorporate into the first extension term and any subsequent extension term thereafter certain “Standard Assurances” as mandated by the NYSOFA), including but not limited to, certain contract provisions applicable to the Program.

The County of Westchester (the “County”), acting by and through the Westchester County Department of Senior Programs and Services (the “Department”), is requesting authorization to enter into an Agreement with the New York State Office for the Aging (“NYSOFA”) to accept a grant in the amount of \$19,611 to provide various support services to caregivers of elderly Westchester County residents 60 years and older under the Caregiver Resource Center program, for the program period commencing on April 1, 2020 and continuing through March 31, 2021 (the “NYSOFA Agreement”).

Additionally, by resolution approved on March 21 2019 (the “March 21st Resolution”) your Honorable Board authorized the County to enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”)

utilizing the NYSOFA grant funds with Westchester Jewish Community Services, Inc. (the "Contractor") to provide various support services to caregivers of elderly Westchester County residents 60 years and older under the Caregiver Resource Center program (the "Program"). State funding for the program period commencing on April 1, 2019 and continuing through March 31, 2020 (the "Initial Term") was for an amount not to exceed \$19,611, payable at the agreed upon unit cost for actual services provided and data entered in NYSOFA's Client Statewide Data System ("PeerPlace"). The Agreement was subsequently executed.

The March 21st Resolution also authorized that the County at its sole option could extend the term of the Agreement with the Contractor for up to four (4) additional one-year periods (each an "Option Term"), at the same unit cost; however, noting that funding could vary from year to year, which would impact the not to exceed amount of the contract, subject to the prior approval of your Honorable Board.

The County now seeks the authority of your Honorable Board to amend the Agreement with the Contractor to provide the Program in order to exercise the first of the County's four (4) Option Terms to renew and extend the term of the Agreement for the program period commencing on April 1, 2020 and continuing through March 31, 2021 (the "First Option Term. State funding for the Program will be at the same amount as the Initial Term (the "First Amendment").

The County also seeks further authority of your Honorable Board to further amend the Agreement with the Contractor in order to incorporate into the First Option Term and any subsequent Option Term thereafter certain "Standard Assurances" as mandated by the NYSOFA), including but not limited to, certain contract provisions applicable to the Program.

Except as specifically to be amended hereunder, all remaining terms and conditions of the initial Agreement with the Contractor shall remain in full force and effect.

For the 2019-2020 program year, WJCS, Caregiver Resource Center (CRC) program provided: 118 units of Counseling to 91(duplicated) participants; 149 units of Support Groups to 86 (duplicated) participants; 63 units to 63 (duplicated) participants; and 433 units of Information to 433 participants.

The Agreement with NYSOFA is for the acceptance of grant funds; therefore, it does not constitute procurement and, as such, is not subject to the Westchester County Procurement Policy. The Agreement with the Contractor is exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3(a) xix thereof.

Upon communication from the Commissioner of the Westchester County Department of Senior Programs and Services, it is hereby:

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Senior Programs and Services (the "Department"), is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with the New York State Office for the Aging ("NYSOFA") to accept a grant in the amount of \$19,611 to provide various support services to caregivers of elderly Westchester County residents 60 years and older under the Caregiver Resource Center program, for the program period commencing on April 1, 2020 and continuing through March 31, 2021 (the "NYSOFA Agreement"); and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County is hereby authorized to amend its agreement (the "Agreement") with Westchester Jewish Community Services, Inc. (the "Contractor") to provide various support services to caregivers of elderly Westchester County residents 60 years and older under the Caregiver Resource Center program (the "Program") in order to exercise the first of the County's four (4) additional one-year periods (each an "Option Term") under the Agreement to renew and extend the term of the Agreement for the program period commencing on April 1, 2020 and continuing through March 31, 2021 (the "First Option Term"). State funding for the Program shall be for an amount not to exceed \$19,611 (the "First Amendment"); and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County is hereby authorized to further amend the Agreement with the Contractor in order to incorporate into the First Option Term and any subsequent Option Term thereafter certain "Standard Assurances" as mandated by the NYSOFA, including but not limited to, certain contract provisions applicable to the Program; and be it further

RESOLVED, that except as specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions of the initial Agreement with the Contractor shall remain in full force and effect; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee be, and hereby is, authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
