**Subject:** **Authority to amend a resolution approved on February 6, 2020 which authorized the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with Hope's Door, Inc. to operate an emergency shelter for adult women and their minor children residing in the County of Westchester who are victims of domestic violence for the period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2024 for an amount not to exceed \$3,318,590 to be paid monthly pursuant to an approved annual budget and subject to appropriation, by changing the eligibility designation from "adult women and their minor children" to simply "adults and children".**

By resolution approved on February 6, 2020 (the "February 6<sup>th</sup> Resolution"), your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Social Services (the "Department"), to enter into an agreement with Hope's Door, Inc. ("Hope's Door"), pursuant to which Hope's Door would operate an emergency shelter known as Hope's Door Shelter for adult women and their minor children residing in the northern zone of the County of Westchester who are victims of domestic violence for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2024 for an amount not to exceed \$3,318,590 to be paid monthly at an approximated per diem rate of \$115.48 pursuant to approved annual budgets (the "Agreement"). The Agreement has not yet been executed.

The Department was recently informed that there can no longer be any gender-based eligibility criteria for domestic violence shelters and that all New York State regulations were revised over the past few years to remove any reference to "women" or "battered women." In order to comply with these new requirements, authority is respectfully requested to amend the February 6<sup>th</sup> Resolution for the limited purpose of changing the eligibility designation from "adult women and their minor children" to simply "adults and children."

Except as otherwise specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions set forth in the February 6<sup>th</sup> Resolution will remain in full force and effect.

A resolution requesting the same is attached for your Honorable Board's approval.

**RESOLUTION**

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of Social Services, be it hereby

**RESOLVED**, that the resolution approved on February 6, 2020 (the “February 6<sup>th</sup> Resolution”) which authorized the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with Hope’s Door, Inc. to operate an emergency shelter known as Hope’s Door Shelter for adult women and their minor children residing in the northern zone of the County of Westchester who are victims of domestic violence for the period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2024 for an amount not to exceed \$3,318,590 to be paid monthly at an approximated per diem rate of \$115.48, pursuant to approved annual budgets, is hereby amended for the limited purpose of changing the eligibility designation from “adult women and their minor children” to simply “adults and children”; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that except as otherwise specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions set forth in the February 6<sup>th</sup> Resolution shall remain in full force and effect; and, be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is empowered to execute any document necessary to implement this Resolution.
