SUBJECT: **Resolution to exempt the procurement of an agreement with Katherine Bailey, LCSW to provide crisis intervention and employee wellness for Department of Social Services employees as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic for the period April 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 pursuant to Section 3(a) xxi of the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures.**

We are requesting that authorization be given to the County of Westchester (“County”) to exempt the procurement of an agreement from the procedures of the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures with Katherine Bailey, LCSW to provide crisis intervention and employee wellness for Department of Social Services employees as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic for the term April 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Katherine Bailey, LCSW has provided employee wellness and training to the Department of Social Services (the “Department”) staff in the past and prepared Sanctuary Model credentials for the Department. Ms. Bailey’s familiarity with Department procedures and employees, will enable her to quickly and effectively provide the crisis intervention services so necessary during the Covid-19 pandemic. It is essential that the individual performing these services has an established relationship with the Department and its employees.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 3(a) xxi, the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures, it is recommended that your Honorable Board determine, by resolution passed prior to commencing the procurement of the CCCW’s services that compliance with procedural requirements of the Policy would not be in the best interest of the County.

Accordingly, a resolution to exempt the procurement of this agreement is hereby submitted for your Honorable Board’s consideration. A separate resolution has been submitted requesting authority to enter into this Agreement.
