Resolution authorizing the reen nonprofit organizing rears to

arrears to prevent evictions in Westchester County.

The attached resolution authorizes the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into grant agreements with ten conprofit organizations in order to provide an Emergency Rental Assistance Program in Westehester County to increase the submission of applications by tenants with rental arrears to prevent evictions. The organizations will provide regional coverage of the County to better direct residents seeking assistance. The total amount of the grants to be awarded to these ten nonprofits is \$1,600,000.00, pursuant to an approved budget, and the term of all the agreements is June 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022. The regional assignments, and amount of the grants, pursuant to approved budgets, is as follows:

Catholic Charities - \$200,000 – Hudson River communities Community Housing Innovations - \$200,000 – Bronx River communities Community Resource Center - \$100,000 – Long Island Sound communities El Centro Hispano - \$100,000 – Central Westchester communities Hudson Valley Justice Center - \$200,000 - County-wide Human Development Services of Westchester \$200,000 - Long Island Sound

The ten nonprofit agencies will participate in the County's Emergency Rental Assistance Program to increase the submission of applications by tenants with rental arrears to prevent evictions. The program will include but not limited, promoting their services to clients and municipalities, posting information on social media, making telephone calls or text messages to clients, spreading informational materials at weekly food distribution locations, assisting households to collect required documents, and assisting households to submit applications through the New York State Emergency Rental Assistance Program portal.

Of the eleven, ten were found to be responsive of the RFP requirements and are included in this authorization. Elizabeth Office Services' proposal was incomplete and disqualified.

RESOLUTION

UPON A COMMUNICATION FROM THE COMMISSIONER OF PLANNING, BE IT HEREBY

RESOLVED: that the County of Westchester is hereby authorized to enter into an agreements with ten nonprofit organizations in order to provide an Emergency Rental Assistance Program in Westchester County to increase the submission of applications by tenants with rental arrears to prevent evictions. The organizations will provide regional coverage of the County to better direct residents seeking assistance, pursuant to an approved budget. The term of all the agreements is June 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022, the regional assignments are as outlined below. The total amount of all the grants to be awarded to these ten nonprofits is \$1,600,000.00, and be it further
