The objective of this contract is to maintain vital life safety systems.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by providing a safe and code compliant work environment at various County facilities, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS). There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.

If this resolution is not approved, potential disruptions of fire alarm systems would require costly emergency repairs. Additionally, per code, the County would be required to provide an around-theclock fire watch until the fire alarm system is restored.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's online financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 10-200 be awarded to SimplexGrinnell LP in the amount of \$709,815.00, subject to appropriations.

This resolution has been reviewed by the Law Department.

### RESOLUTION

#### **CONTRACT NO. 10-200**

Upon communication from the Acting Commissioner of Public Works, be it

**RESOLVED**, that Contract No. 10-200 for Countywide Maintenance Service For Fire Alarm Systems, Various Locations, Westchester County, New York be and is hereby awarded to the sole bidder, SimplexGrinnell LP, 12 Jeanne Drive, Newburgh, New York 12550 in the amount of \$709,815.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this contract is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
