SUBJECT: Authority to enter into an Agreement with Rising Ground, Inc. pursuant to which Rising Ground, Inc. will provide residential treatment services to a homeless young adult male suffering from chronic mental illness who is under the care of DSS adult protective services for a term commencing retroactive to June 8, 2022 and continuing through June 7, 2023 in an amount not-to-exceed \$160,031.00, payable at a daily rate determined by New York State.

Attached for your Honorable Board's consideration is a resolution which, if approved, would authorize the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Social Services ("DSS"), to enter into an agreement with Rising Ground, Inc. ("Rising Ground"), pursuant to which Rising Ground will provide residential treatment services to a homeless young adult male suffering from chronic mental illness who is under the care of DSS adult protective services (the "Agreement"). The term of the Agreement will commence retroactive to June 8, 2022 and continue through June 7, 2023. In consideration for services to be rendered, the County will pay Rising Ground an amount not-to-exceed \$160,031.00, payable at a daily rate determined by New York State.

DSS adult protective services is seeking a mental health placement for a homeless young adult male suffering with chronic mental illness. Pending this placement, the customer is being temporarily cared for at Rising Ground.

This Agreement is exempt from the County Procurement Policy pursuant to section 3(a) xvii thereof which exempts contracts for the care and treatment of the mentally ill. In addition, since the Agreement is being funded through the Medicaid Program, a combined federal and state entitlement program, the terms of provider relations are dictated by Title XIX of the Social Security Act and the approved Medicaid State Plan. As such, the requirements of the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (formerly, Federal Common Grant Rules), do not apply.

The public purpose of this agreement is to ensure that the customer's physical needs are met and that he is able to be safely maintained at the residential facility.

The goals and objectives will be tracked and monitored by DSS staff.

An appropriate resolution is herewith attached for your Honorable Board's consideration.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of the Department of Social Services, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester, acting by and through its Department of Social Services (the "DSS"), is authorized to enter into an agreement with Rising Ground, Inc. ("Rising Ground"), pursuant to which Rising Ground will provide residential treatment services to a homeless young adult male suffering from chronic mental illness who is under the care of DSS adult protective services, for a term commencing retroactive to June 8, 2022 and continuing through June 7, 2023 for an amount not-to-exceed \$160,031.00, payable at a daily rate determined by New York State; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is subject to County Appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is empowered to execute all documents and take all actions necessary to effect the purpose of this resolution.
