SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing an Agreement Between the County of Westchester and the Village of Ossining for sidewalk improvements on James and Williams Streets in the Village.

The attached resolution, if approved by your Honorable Board, would authorize the County of Westchester ("County") to enter into an agreement with the Village of Ossining (the "Village"), pursuant to which the Village will conduct sidewalk improvements on James and Williams Streets (the "Project") in the Village. In consideration for providing such services, the County will pay the Village an amount not-to-exceed \$200,000 in Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funding, pursuant to an approved budget. The term of the agreement will commence on August 1, 2022 and continue through September 1, 2023.

The Village plans to do a sidewalk improvement project on James and Williams Streets that will replace the broken sidewalks and curbs at the Project site that have deteriorated and are hazardous to the pedestrians. The Project will include, but not be limited to, the replacement of the curbs and sidewalks.

The goal and objective of the Project is to ensure the public safety for the residents in this area by replacing the sidewalk and curbs that have deteriorated. The Project will be monitored by the Department of Planning staff and Village Public Works staff during construction.

This procurement is in compliance with the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures, pursuant to Section 3(a)xvi thereof, which exempts contracts with recipients for disbursement of grants or loans under the Community Development Block Grant Program.

Act # 33-2021, adopted March 8, 2021, by the Westchester County Board of Legislators, authorized the County to submit an Urban County Application under the Federal Community Development Block Grant, Emergency Solutions Grant, and HOME Investment Programs, amending the FY 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan to include the FY 2021 Action Plan.

On May 20, 2021, the Board of Acquisition and Contract approved a resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to accept a grant totaling \$4,267,448 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

I recommend approval of this agreement.

RESOLUTION

UPON A COMMUNICATION FROM THE COMMISSIONER OF PLANNING, BE IT HEREBY

RESOLVED: that the County of Westchester (the "County") is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Village of Ossining (the "Village"), pursuant to which the Village will perform pedestrian safety infrastructure improvements on James and Williams Streets in the Village, including the replacement of deteriorated curbs and sidewalks, for a term commencing on August 1, 2022 and continuing through September 1, 2023; and be it further

RESOLVED: that in consideration for performing said services, the County shall pay the Village an amount not-to-exceed \$200,000 in Community Development Block Grant Program funding, to be paid pursuant to an approved budget; and be it further

RESOLVED: that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is authorized to execute any documents and take any actions necessary to effectuate purposes hereof.
