The 2010 Operating Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to perform maintenance and repair on traffic signals, controllers, conflict monitors and communications equipment at all County maintained traffic signals. This contract is for a term of three (3) years.

The objective of this contract is to maintain traffic signal equipment and to improve safety conditions along County roads.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the County's roads meet current codes and standards, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS). There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.

If this resolution is not approved, traffic control equipment could fail to operate, thereby creating potentially hazardous conditions for the traveling public.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.
