The 2010 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to power-wash and repaint the ceiling, columns, curbs and crosswalks of the White Plains Bus Terminal. The project also includes installation of new directional color coded signage.

The objective of this contract is to clean and repaint the terminal along with providing a color coded identification system for the bus lanes.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the White Plains Bus Terminal meets standards for pedestrian safety, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS). There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.

If this resolution is not approved, deteriorating safety markings could eventually pose a hazard to pedestrians.

The department will utilize Primavera Software Management tools to track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

Payment for this contract will be made from American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) funds, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that this advertisement for bids will state that pursuant to Chapter 308 of the Laws of the County of Westchester, the policy of the County is to encourage the meaningful and significant participation on County contracts for business enterprises owned by persons of color and women - Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE); and be it further
