The 2010 Grant Account contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to install a subsurface gravel wetland for stormwater treatment. The system will consist of two (2) sedimentation forebays and two (2) filter basins, installed with native plantings appropriate to wetland and floodplain areas.

The objective of this contract is to improve the water quality of stormwater runoff from the Bronx River Parkway.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will provide an environmental benefit by reducing flooding and erosion, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

Payment for this entire contract will be made from the United States Department of Agriculture – Natural Resources Conservation Service Grant, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.
