Re: **Authority is hereby requested for the County of Westchester to enter into agreements with seven (7) licensed consultants as listed in Schedule "A" to provide psychological testing and evaluations, psychiatric evaluations, mental health evaluations, sibling consults, fire setting evaluations, safety assessments and court ordered psychotherapy to uninsured parents and children who have been subjects of Child Protective Service Reports and families in which at least one (1) child is at risk of foster care placement or in which at least one (1) child has been placed in foster care for the period January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$217,125 to be paid at rates listed in Schedule "B" pursuant to an approved budget and subject to appropriation**

Authority is hereby requested for the County of Westchester to enter into agreements with seven (7) licensed consultants as listed in Schedule "A" to provide psychological testing and evaluations, psychiatric evaluations, mental health evaluations, sibling consults, fire setting evaluations, safety assessments and court ordered psychotherapy to uninsured parents and children who have been subjects of Child Protective Service Reports and families in which at least one (1) child is at risk of foster care placement or in which at least one (1) child has been placed in foster care, for the period January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$217,125 to be paid at rates listed in Schedule "B" pursuant to an approved budget and subject to appropriation. The aggregate not-to-exceed amount requested reflects a 10 % reduction of the 2010 contract amount. This contract is a fee for service, paid at an hourly rate, therefore the reduction in contract NTE will not impact the number of families to be served.

All consultants are paid at an hourly rate for the actual time spent in review of referral records, interviews, conferences, interpreting test results and preparation of reports. The

Consultants shall be available, upon request of the County Attorney, to testify in Family Court or other related proceedings as to the Consultants' evaluative findings and/or assessment of therapeutic progress. The Consultants will be compensated for such time and appearance by the Department. The consultants are not compensated by the Department or the County Attorney's office if they are subpoenaed or called as a witness by the Court, the Law Guardian or any other party other than the County of Westchester.

These contracts serve a **public purpose** in that the licensed consultants provide professional expertise in the areas of evaluations, assessments and court ordered psychotherapy, thereby enabling the Department to provide appropriate referrals and services as recommended.

The **goals and objectives** of these contracts are to provide psychological testing and evaluations, psychiatric evaluations, mental health evaluations, sibling consults, fire setting evaluations, safety assessments and court ordered psychotherapy to uninsured parents and children who have been subjects of Child Protective Service reports and families in which at least one child is at risk of foster care placement or in which at least one child has been placed in foster care. The services provided by the Consultants allow for interventions that promote the psychological and physical well-being of the child and/or parent as well as to assist and facilitate the reunification of the family, where required.

The **goals and objectives are in the best interests of the County in terms of public health and public safety** because they are aimed at providing clinical evaluations of the clients referred to the Consultant. These evaluations help the Department to identify the mental health and/or developmental problems of the clients, including both children and parents and make appropriate referrals, which would, in turn, help to reduce the risk of abuse, neglect or maltreatment.

The **goals and objectives are in the best interests of the County in terms of fiscal responsibility** as the services provided by the Consultant assist the Department in determining the appropriate level of services needed by the clients, thereby helping to avert placements and the costs associated with placements. Further, because the services will be provided at an hourly rate, payments will be made for the actual time the Consultant spends on each case which, in turn, would provide for more accountability on the part of the Department and the Consultants.

The **goals and objectives of this program will be tracked and monitored** to evaluate the success using the Performance Measurement Indicators developed by the Department and approved by the County Budget Office. They include feedback from District Office staff as well as the periodic review of reports submitted by the Consultant.

Based on the **Performance Measurement Indicators submitted**, the Department is able to report that the Consultants have met the established measurement indicators set forth in the Scope of Work. All Consultants have accepted and evaluated 100% of all referrals received.

Given below is the information on the number of families each consultant served according to statistics available as of September 30, 2010:

Jose Arcaya, Ph.D., Esq. has provided services to 16 families.

Diagnostics, LLP, has provided services for 22 families.

Manuel Lopez-Leon, M.D., has provided services for 5 families

Julie Low, M.D., has provided services for 17 families

Montego Medical Consulting Services, LLC, has provided services for 13 families.

Elizabeth Osborn, M.D., has provided services for 12 families.

Westchester Jewish Community Services, Inc., has provided services for 25 families.

These contracts are exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3(a) (vii) and (viii).

Accordingly, the County of Westchester is hereby requesting permission to enter into agreements with seven (7) licensed consultants as described above.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Acting Commissioner of the Department of Social Services, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with seven (7) licensed consultants as listed in Schedule "A" to provide psychological testing and evaluations, psychiatric evaluations, mental health evaluations, sibling consults, fire setting evaluations, safety assessments and court ordered psychotherapy to uninsured parents and children who have been subjects of Child Protective Service Reports and families in which at least one (1) child is at risk of foster care placement or in which at least one (1) child has been placed in foster care for the period from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$217,125 to be paid at rates listed in Schedule "B" attached hereto and made a part hereof pursuant to an approved budget; and be it further

RESOLVED, that these agreements are subject to County Appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that these agreements are also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of these agreements. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate these agreements or renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Consultant, then the Consultant shall have the right to terminate the agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is empowered to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
