SUBJECT: **Request authority to enter into an agreement with Daytop Village Incorporated in an amount not to exceed \$331,977 in state aid for the period beginning July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 to provide chemical dependency treatment to families and individuals in Westchester County**

Authority is requested for the Department of Community Mental Health to enter into an agreement with Daytop Village Incorporated to provide chemical dependency treatment to families and individuals in a total amount not to exceed \$331,977 for the period July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011.

The proposed agreement will serve a public purpose by enabling the Department to implement the purpose of Article 25 and/or 41 of the New York Mental Hygiene law and Westchester County Local law No. 1-1978.

The goals and objectives of the proposed agreement are to provide chemical dependency treatment for individuals and families in Westchester County leading to a healthy, drug-free life through services that are individual, comprehensive and multidisciplinary without regard to race, religion, nationality or socio-economic status.

This agreement is exempt from the County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3, (a) xvii. The Agency is reimbursed against the approved budget in accordance with the applicable percentages of State, County and Federal Aid.

The funds for this agreement are reimbursed by the State Office of Mental Health.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of the Department of Community Mental Health, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that authority is granted to the Department of Community Mental Health to enter into an agreement with Daytop Village, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$331,977 for the period July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011; and be it further

RESOLVED, that Daytop Village, Inc. will provide chemical dependency treatment to families and individuals in Westchester County; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that this contract is subject to County Appropriation; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is authorized and empowered to execute and deliver all instruments and take all actions necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.

and it is further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee be and hereby is authorized and empowered to execute this agreement for the County of Westchester.
