On April 6, 2011, four (04) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 10-509 for HVAC Equipment Upgrades and Odor Control Improvements, Yonkers Joint Wastewater Treatment Plant, Yonkers, New York.

Subsequent to the receipt of bids, it was determined that substantial revisions to the scope of work of this contract are required. The scope of work change pertains primarily to the County's pre-purchase of the odor control equipment in order to ensure compatibility with the available space at the Yonkers Joint Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Therefore, it is requested that all bids be rejected and re-advertised as Contract No. 10-509-Rev.

The objective of this contract is to allow the Department of Environmental Facilities to maintain its treatment plant systems and to ensure continuous and reliable processing of wastewater.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring continued uninterrupted operation of the plant's wastewater treatment systems. This project will enable the Department of Environmental Facilities to carry out its basic mission to provide wastewater treatment and maintain satisfactory water quality, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
