On April 20, 2011, four (04) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 09-514 for Biological Nutrient Removal Facilities, New Rochelle Wastewater Treatment Plant, New Rochelle, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Yonkers Contracting Company, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$94,211,500.00, and has proposed the utilization of the following subcontractors: Clean Air Quality Service, Inc. (HVAC and Plumbing Work), 161 Brady Avenue, Hawthorne, New York 10532; and West-Fair Electrical Contracting, Inc. (Electrical Work), 200 Brady Avenue, Hawthorne, New York 10532.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Yonkers Contracting Company, Inc.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to upgrade the plant for nitrogen removal as required by the Order-On-Consent with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will fulfill the Order-On-Consent, thus avoiding fines, and it will promote the health and safety of the general public by reducing the discharge of pollutants into the receiving water of Long Island Sound. This project addresses the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The project will provide an environmental benefit by reducing the amount of nitrogen in effluent wastewater discharged into Long Island Sound.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 09-514 be awarded to Yonkers Contracting Company, Inc. in the amount of \$94,211,500.00.
