The 2011 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to relocate existing utilities including electric, communications, water and natural gas.

In accordance with Local Law No. 1-1998, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this contract is to facilitate future upgrades to the Airport's electrical and deicing facilities.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the Airport meets FAA standards for deicing facilities, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS). There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

Payment for this entire contract will be made from the Airport Special Revenue Fund and Passenger Facility Charges, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.
