On August 3, 2011, six (06) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 11-519 for Roof Replacement, Primary Settling Tank Area, Port Chester Wastewater Treatment Plant, Port Chester, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that BBR Contracting Corp. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$114,000.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that BBR Contracting Corp.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.  
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to maintain the weather tightness of the shelter for the Primary Settling Tank Area.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will extend the life of the existing structure.

There are no environmental or energy components associated with this project.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 11-519 be awarded to BBR Contracting Corp. in the amount of \$114,000.00.

# RESOLUTION

## CONTRACT NO. 11-519

Upon communication from the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation, be it

**RESOLVED**, that Contract No. 11-519 for Roof Replacement Primary Settling Tank Area, Port Chester Wastewater Treatment Plant, Port Chester, New York be and is hereby awarded to the low bidder, BBR Contracting Corp., 163 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, Brooklyn, New York 11232, in the amount of \$114,000.00; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that this contract is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
